It has been 10 years since we found out about what happened at Winterbourne View



The BBC Panorama showed us the abuse that happened to people with learning disabilities who were living at Winterbourne View



Transforming Care agenda was developed to try and move people out of placements that are not right for the person



But it has been a slow process and a lot of people are still living in hospitals. Sometimes for a lot of years



More abuse to people with learning disabilities has since happened (Whorlton Hall and Yew Trees)



There is a lot of work being done now to make services better in the community for people with learning disabilities



University of Hertfordshire are doing research with people with learning disabilities





They have been asking about their experiences of moving and what has helped



This research will help to show what is important to supporting someone to move into the community and stay there



This will hopefully mean less abuse happens and people will live a happy life in the community
